WHO WE ARE:

Welcome to Beaverton Community Band, one of Washington County's cherished music organizations. We began in 1978 with only a handful of adult musicians and have since grown to 65. Each year, we offer our audiences new musical experiences via indoor, outdoor, and ensemble concerts. Each season, we continue to expand our offerings while bringing new members and audiences to our sound. As a non-audition band, we play and perform for each other to create a quality experience for our audiences, young and old, offer a rewarding musical experience for our members, and engage with our community to support young musicians. We promote a team-oriented effort that allows individual members to express themselves musically in an open and inviting atmosphere. In doing so, we get better and are better for it – thanks to the efforts of our staff, members, and associated families. We perform three formal indoor concerts each season and multiple outdoor concerts in Washington County, OR.

REF: THE POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Director conducts and is responsible for all band rehearsals and performances. He/she selects the musical literature to be rehearsed and performed by the band. The Director has control over artistic decisions, taking into account the history/traditions of the Beaverton Community Band and band members' capabilities, and will be open to suggestions from the Board of Directors and band members.

The Director is a non-voting member of the Board of Directors and is expected to attend monthly board meetings and provide input on the Band's direction and administration. The position is under contract with the Band and includes a negotiated per-service stipend.

1. Documentation of relevant directing experience to include videos, testimonials, and Letters of Recommendation
2. Proof of Teaching Certificates or certifications
3. Secondary Education References.
